Greetings to one and all. I am happy to write this message for inclusion in our Spring Newsletter. Spring is highlighted and celebrated many ways in society. It is celebrated with the coming of longer hours of daylight. It is celebrated with the first Spring flowers coming to bloom. In my younger years, it was celebrated by receiving (at Easter) a chocolate egg nestled on bright yellow straw like paper in the bottom of a brightly painted china tea cup and saucer. But, what I remember most about Spring is the spiritual journey taken through Lent and the celebration of Christ's Resurrection on Easter morning. As people of faith we still take this Spiritual journey. It is a journey that assures us of the depth of God's love for us.

"When I Survey the Wondrous Cross" is one of my favourite hymns. This hymn was written by Isaac Watts and it is one of his greatest. The words of the hymn bid us gaze upon the cross and then respond with our readiness to accept this one great act as the wonder of God's unconditional love. Lent leads us through the journey of Jesus to Jerusalem, his crucifixion on Good Friday, and his glorious resurrection on Easter Sunday. These happenings are at the center of our faith and challenge us to see that the gift of God's love through Jesus is universal. This is God's promise. The wonderful thing to realize about this Holy time of the year is that we are heirs of this great promise of God. We, as heirs of this promise, are called to continue this ministry by telling the astonishing story that God invites all people everywhere to

experience this promise of “New Life.” The last verse of Watts’ hymn indicates how we are to strive daily to accept and spread that promise.

*Were the whole realm of nature mine,
that were a present far to small:
love so amazing, so divine,
demands my soul, my life, my all.*

The coming of Spring includes the coming of Easter. Easter brings us a new experience that cannot be compared to other experiences. The Easter message is not just about a change in Jesus, but also about change in all faithful followers. We cannot explain it all and maybe to live as an Easter people is to live with mystery and to allow that mystery to transform us. When we experience that inner joy of Easter we also become aware that the empty tomb and the news that Jesus is alive opens up for us the reality that Christ is present all around us.

A verse of a well-known hymn indicates this reality. This verse is my prayer that as you celebrate Spring and the Easter Season you will also experience the “full” promise that, through Jesus, God walks with us in our daily lives. Indeed, let us celebrate the Easter message as we resolve to, not only see the face of Christ in everyone we meet, but that everyone we meet will see the face of Christ in us. My wife Dianne joins with me in offering a prayer that this Lenten and Easter Season will be one of meditation, peace and blessing for you.

*We meet you, O Christ, in many a guise,
Your image we see in simple and wise.
You live in a palace, exist in a shack.
We see you, the gardener, a tree on your back.*

Message from the Treasurer

Greetings! At the Annual Congregational Meeting on March 9, I was pleased to present the financial results for 2013 and a Budget for 2014. Firstly, thank you to all for your part in the important and exciting work of Topsail United Church and for responding faithfully to the generosity of God.

The approved Budget projects a deficit of \$11,369, primarily due to a provision for washroom renovations in the Church Hall, estimated to cost approximately \$20,000. Preparing a Budget is an opportunity to revisit and critically review all costs associated with running the Church on a day-to-day basis.

As most expenditures are fixed in nature and generally increase from year to year, there isn't much room for reductions. While we have projected a deficit, we would very much like to, at best, break even. To do so, we need your help. May we suggest that you thoughtfully reconsider your level of contribution to the work of TUC? Perhaps a contribution to our Roofing Fund?
