WELCOME! On this 2nd Sunday of Advent we reflect on Zechariah's song of praise and prophecy as he blesses his son, John, cascades into promises of hope for the people. The anticipated ministry of John recalls the prophecy of Malachi, and looks forward to God's reign of righteousness and peace.

One: For God leads us with joy in the light of God's glory, with mercy and righteousness.

All: Let us worship God with joy. Let us worship and sing praise!
